

# Road Map to Volunteering at the Library

## A guide for students going into 6th-12th grades



### Ready, Set, Go!

Beginning in June, any student interested in volunteering must register for Teen Read—our summer library program for kids going into 6th-12th grades.



### Rest Area!

Have you finished a book? Fill out a book questionnaire at the library, letting us know about what you've read. These forms are how we keep track of the books that you've read, and you can get a raffle ticket each time you turn one in!

### PULL OVER!



Teen Read participants who fail to read and report on at least 5 books by the end of the program will not be eligible for library volunteer hours, and they will forfeit any hours earned during Summer Reading.

### Stop 1: The Library



Sign up for Teen Read and begin reading books you've checked out from the Library. *All Teen Read participants who want to volunteer are required to read and report on at least 5 books by the end of Teen Read!*

### You Made It!



At the end of Teen Read, all participants who have successfully completed the requirements will be eligible for volunteer hours throughout the school year.

### Readers at Work!



Teen Read participants who are going into 7th-12th grades will be given volunteer opportunities during Summer Reading. Beginning in August, Teen Read participants/finishers in 6th grade will be eligible for volunteer hours.
